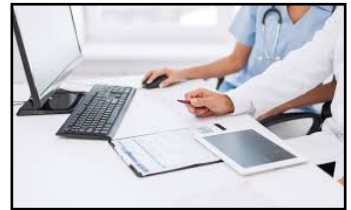

The Electronic Health Record system contains and securely shares critical information such as a patient's medical history, diagnoses, medications, treatment plans, immunization dates, allergies, x-ray images, laboratory and other diagnostic tests results, billing and scheduling information, and more.

The new Electronic Medical Record will improve our care of our patients. However, as is the case with any new system, the learning curve for staff will take some time. Our staff's goal is to provide excellent health services, however, during the initial month of implementation we expect some time delays in the provision of services.
