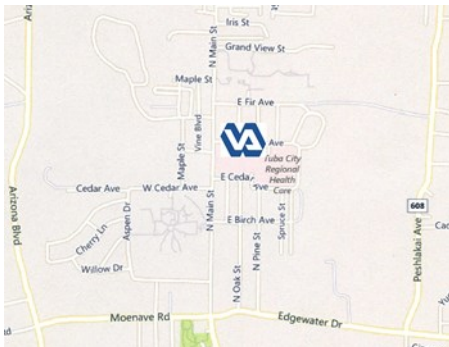

Tuba City VA Clinic

Description of Program:

The Tuba City VA Clinic is designed to bring primary care services to Veterans in their own community through a combination of face-to-face and telehealth appointments. Limited walk-in services are available at this facility.

Access to Care:

The clinic provides you with visits on a regular basis, and as recommended by your assigned VA health care team.

Routine and Urgent Care

Information: If you feel you must be seen before your next scheduled provider appointment, the Tuba City VA Clinic has medical staff on-site to address **non-life-threatening situations**. If you have an emergency you will be directed to go to the nearest emergency facility; local Emergency Room (ER), Phoenix VA, or Northern Arizona VA Urgent Care. VA will determine if the episode of care meets appropriate non-VA medical administrative and clinical eligibility for payment.

Prescription/Pharmacy Information:

Your provider may prescribe medications for you. The prescribed medications are ordered through the computer system and are directed to the Northern AZ VA Health Care System Pharmacy Service. The medication will be delivered directly to your mailing address. You may use ***MyHealthVet*** to order medications or for refills, call 928-445-4860, then press 1 to speak to a Call Center Representative or call the automated refill line at 1-800-949-1005 ext. 7470 after receiving your medications. Under certain circumstances medications may be provided through the TCRHCC Pharmacy.

Laboratory Information: The Tuba City VA Clinic utilizes the TCRHCC lab on premises for blood collection and is ordered by the VA Provider. Please make sure you are fasting when required by your provider.

Primary Care Appointments:

Please come to your appointment at least 30 minutes early for Health Preventive Screening and check-in.
