Water Contamination Incident at TCRHCC

On April 21, 2025, at 10:34 am, Tuba City Regional Health Care Corporation (TCRHCC) investigated an issue with the water lines in the Main Hospital building and later identified the involving contamination in the building's water supply. As a safety measure, water service in the Main Hospital has been shut off and is not in use for any purpose, including by staff. We are currently testing the water lines to determine the full extent of the issue.

Clinics in the Main Hospital Building are temporarily closed until further notice.

Important Information for Patients and Visitors:

- The Emergency Department remains open.
- All bathrooms and drinking fountains in the Main Hospital Building are currently closed. However, alternative restrooms and drinking water are available in the three-story Outpatient Primary Care Center (OPCC).
- Patients with scheduled appointments in the affected clinics will be contacted directly by clinic staff to reschedule appointments.
- The inpatient department is working closely with local healthcare facilities to transfer patients as necessary, ensuring continuity of care and patient safety.

Our teams are working with environmental and health authorities to resolve the issue and ensure the safety of our water supply before resuming normal operations.
