Water Incident at TCRHCC — Update

TUBA CITY, Ariz. — As of September 10, 2025, there are no changes to report regarding the water contamination incident that began on September 8, 2025, when Tuba City Regional Health Care Corporation (TCRHCC) activated a Code Green in response to a water line issue affecting the following facilities:

- Administration Building
- Specialty Care Center
- General Services
- South Oak Housing

As a precautionary safety measure, water services to the impacted buildings remain shut off and are not to be used for drinking, sanitation, or any other purpose. Water line testing is still underway to determine the scope and cause of the issue.

Continuity of Operations (No Change):

- The Specialty Care Center continues to operate from the Main Hospital (Adult Care Unit) to ensure uninterrupted patient care.
- The Mental Health Department remains operational and is conducting all appointments in-person at the Mental Health Clinic, located off Main Street.

Patient and Visitor Information (No Change):

- The Emergency Department remains open.
- All bathrooms and drinking fountains in the Main Hospital Building and Outpatient Primary Care Center (OPCC) are operational.
- Patients with scheduled appointments in affected clinics will be contacted directly by clinic staff.

Next Steps:

- Continued assessment and testing of the water infrastructure
- Ongoing coordination with Facilities Management and local water services
- Further updates will be provided as new information becomes available
