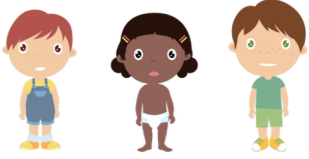
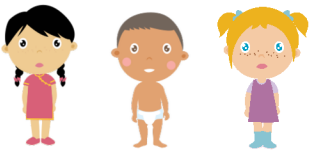


# Measles

Measles can be dangerous, especially for babies and young children.



## MEASLES SYMPTOMS TYPICALLY INCLUDE

- High fever (may spike to more than 104° F)
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Red, watery eyes
- Rash breaks out 3-5 days after symptoms begin



## Measles Can Be Serious



About 1 out of 4 people who get measles will be hospitalized.



1 out of every 1,000 people with measles will develop brain swelling due to infection (encephalitis), which may lead to brain damage.



1 or 2 out of 1,000 people with measles will die, even with the best care.



## You have the power to protect your child.

Provide your children with **safe** and **long-lasting protection** against measles by making sure they get the **measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine** on schedule.



## The MMR vaccine is 97% effective.

Your child should get their MMR vaccines at **12 months** and **4 years** of age. Call TCRHCC Pediatric Clinic at **928-283-2501** to confirm if your child is up-to-date.
